FINDING FOCUS
MEETING WITH CONGRESSIONAL PROBLEM SOLVERS CAUCUS



On Monday, June 7 members of the New Jersey Jewish Business Alliance and guests spoke with Members of Congress and Co-Chairs of the Problem Solvers Caucus, Rep. Josh Gottheimer (D-NJ) and Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick (R-PA)

Founded in 2017, the Problem Solvers Caucus is a independent member-driven group in Congress. Along side members from across the country, Rep. Josh Gottheimer and Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick are committed to “finding common ground on many of the key issues facing the nation.” (About the Caucus, PSC)

Speaking to the attendees, Rep. Josh Gottheimer and Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick stressed the need and their determination to find bipartisan solutions to issues such as: Coronavirus recovery & planning, reinvestment in US infrastructure, criminal justice reform and stabilizing health care.

Addressing the current challenges facing local business such as the hiring crisis and taxes, the panel and audience members alike expressed a desire for

transparency, accessibility and openness going forth.

Both Rep. Josh Gottheimer and Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick stressed the need for individuals, businesses and government to continue working across the isle as we support local business and combat rising antisemitism.

Heard of the NJ Secure Choice Savings Program, but not sure if or how it could impact your business? On Wednesday, June 23 members of the New Jersey Jewish Business Alliance gathered to learn how NJJBA can help business avoid costly fines and attract and retain talent.

NJJBA was delighted to welcome our members back for an in-person event at the Robert Treat Hotel, Newark as we joined to understand the NJ Small Business Retirement Marketplace Act.

This new legislation will require certain NJ employers to provide a retirement plan for their employees from March 2021. Attendees learned more about the bill designed to remove the barriers to entry into the retirement market for

small businesses which employ half of New Jersey's private workforce and explored the impacts on their businesses.

NJJBA also announced the launch of their member-only discounted 401K plan. Along with our partners at Topaz HR Advisory and LPL Group, NJJBA have crafted a special NJJBA 401K plan, for our members to have a cost effective retirement plan to offer to their employees.
